FULL-TIME LECTURER AD

The Department of Geography at the University of Washington invites applications for a full-time lecturer in the areas of critical GIS, geovisualization and digital geographies. Thematic specializations in nature/society relations, health geography, geopolitics and poverty/inequality are preferred. The successful candidate will teach GIS and geovisualization at the introductory and advanced levels, including courses on spatial databases, web cartographies, spatial computation, and coding for geospatial applications. The Department seeks a dynamic, innovative instructor who will substantially contribute to the Department's undergraduate curriculum. This is a nine-month position extending for two years with the possibility of renewal and begins September 16, 2018. Candidates must hold a Ph.D. or foreign equivalent in geography or a related field. Technical expertise in areas such as web cartography, spatial computation or geovisualization is preferred. The candidate will teach two undergraduate courses in fall, winter and spring quarters in the Department's GIS, Mapping and Society concentration for a total of six courses during the academic year.
